

Picasso

A painter, engraver and sculptor, Marc Chagall (1887-1985) was born in Russia of Orthodox Jewish stock. After an early working visit to Paris he made his home there in 1923, spending the war years in the United States. Rather than the wine, it was the living fruit of the vine, speared by a thrush or fed by a mother to her child, that Chagall chose to bring us here for the 1970 Mouton Rothschild label.

One of the grossest errors propagated about Picasso, and one we hear most often, is the idea that he is something to do with the Surrealists. In fact, in the majority of his paintings, the subject is almost always completely down to earth, never drawn from the dim world of dreams, never capable of being turned into a symbol, in other words not in any way Surrealist. Human limbs, human subjects in human surroundings; that is first and foremost what we find in Picasso. Michel Leiris, Document 2, 1930.

Robert Parker - 100 Points

Born in Philadelphia, Andy Warhol (1930-1987) began as a commercial artist in an advertising agency and was to become one of the leading exponents of Pop Art, which he himself defined as "the art of making the ordinary original". For the 1975 Mouton Rothschild label, Warhol, working as always from photographs, is in semi-serious mood, juxtaposing different studies of Baron Philippe.

Best known as a film director, but also a boxer, art lover, writer, horsetrainer, big-game hunter and actor, John Huston (1906-1987) was a talented painter from an early age. His dedication: "In celebration of my beloved friend Baron Philippe's sixtieth harvest at Mouton", bears witness both to his affection for the man and his attachment to a place that clearly enchanted him.

Born in Pennsylvania, the American sculptor and painter Keith Haring (1958-1990) became during the Eighties one of the best-known creators of New York's "East Village". His design for the 1988 Mouton Rothschild vintage is a satirical version of the Dancing Rams theme, perhaps also making an ironic reference to Mouton Rothschild's official coat of arms.

Balthus is the pseudonym of Count Balthazar Klossowski de Rola (1908-2001). Portraits, landscapes, city streets or interiors, Balthus's work is classical in its measure and its subject matter, its mastery and its composition, echoing both the Italian Quattrocento, Courbet and Cézanne. The drawing he made for Mouton Rothschild 1993 returns to a recurrent motive in this work: the dreamy adolescent girl, willful, graceful and fragile... All the hypnotic power of a style that is both limpid and full of mystery, leading us away to distant lands of fantasy and desire.

Born in Paris of parents from the Aveyron region, who kept a café-restaurant, Raymond Savignac (1907-2002) displayed a gift for caricature from a very early age. His first decisive encounter occurred in 1933 when he met the famous poster artist Cassandre, who set him on his way by taking him on as his assistant at the Alliance Graphique. Seventy-five years after Jean Carlu, the poster designer who created the first artist's label for Mouton Rothschild in 1924, the wheel has come full circle with the design for the 1999 vintage by another master of poster art, Savignac.

Born in Oaxaca (Mexico) into a family of Zapotecan Indian origin, Rufino Tamayo (1899-1991) is one of the most renowned Mexican artists of the 20th century. He offered the Mexican people an outstanding collection of contemporary art, including an eclectic choice of his own works, which led to the creation of the Rufino Tamayo International Museum in Mexico City in 1981. In 1990, Tamayo agreed to create an original work of art for the Mouton Rothschild label. Fate decreed otherwise, but his family wanted the master's wish to be fulfilled. So to illustrate the 1998 vintage they have given us this "Brindis", a man proposing a toast: a commonplace ritual that Tamayo transforms, under a glowing sun, into a striking allegory of raw desire.

THE AUGSBURG RAM - For 2000, in an exceptional departure from this tradition, Baroness Philippine has not commissioned a painter. The bottle "in person" has become a collector's item, its very glass adorned with a treasure from the Museum of Wine in Art at Mouton: the little "Augsburg Ram", a chased silver-gilt drinking vessel created around 1590 by Jakob Schenauer, a German master goldsmith. The arms, the name, the vintage and the owner's signature have been screen-printed in gold.

Born at Waco (Texas) in 1941, Robert (Bob) Wilson studied at the University of Texas and Brooklyn's Pratt Institute before taking an interest in sculpture and architecture. This was followed during the 1960s by various theatrical experiences in the United States, in university circles and in his own Byrd Hoffman School of Byrds. For the label for Mouton Rothschild 2001, Bob Wilson has chosen to set his friend Philippine in a symphony of colours in which the green of the vine shoots and the gold of the sun harmonize with the chromatic scale of the wine, from light red to deep purple.

Born in 1933 at Dniepropetrovsk, in what is now Ukraine, Ilya Kabakov is one of the leading figures of contemporary Russian art. He has taken American citizenship. Trained at Moscow Art School and the V.I. Surikov Institute, he made a name for himself in the late 1950s as a graphic artist and book illustrator. For the label of Mouton Rothschild 2002, Kabakov expresses both his mastery of graphic art and his predilection for multidimensional space in a striking use of perspective. He has entitled his drawing "OKHO", meaning window in Russian.
